Open Incentive Program

Get up to \$30 of participation fees reimbursed!**

What is it?

The MHAO Open Incentive is a reimbursement program. Current MHAO memberships are eligible to receive up to **\$30** of fees back a year when participating in "Open to All Breed" activities with a registered Morgan Horse.

How much?

The MHAO Board has approved an annual maximum of **\$30** per membership, and **\$10** per event effective November 1st, 2024**. Here's an Example for a Family Membership with 2 adults and 1 youth:

		Fees Paid	Reimbursement
March	Adult 1 participates in a poker ride	\$5	\$5
April	Adult 2 participates in a dressage event	\$180	\$10
May	Youth participates in a schooling show	\$25	\$10
May	Adult 2 participates in a clinic	\$60	\$5
August	Youth participates at the county fair	\$50	\$0
Total Reimbursed to Membership			\$30

What kind of activities?

An activity or event is eligible if it is a non-MHAO event open to all breeds (OTAB) and requires a participation or entry fee. Even if the event has a Morgan only class, as long as it is primarily open to all breeds, it is eligible. Breed shows and activities significantly sponsored by Morgan Clubs are not included. Examples of eligible activities and events are:

- 👉 State and county fairs
- 👉 Local horse shows; including, schooling shows
- 👉 Dressage events
- 👉 Combined driving events (CDE)
- 👉 Extreme, or competitive trail riding
- 👉 Endurance rides
- 👉 Poker rides
- 👉 Horsemanship clinics
- 👉 Expositions
- 👉 Parades

How do I get my reimbursement?

If you need a form or have questions, call or email Sandi Humphres. Events must occur between November 1 and October 31. Members will need to send the form to Karen Breckenridge, MHAO Treasurer, with proof of payment within 30 days of the event. She will track your reimbursement history & forward it to Sandi once the reimbursement is paid. Reimbursed fees are what would be considered entry fees and do not include travel to or from the venue.
